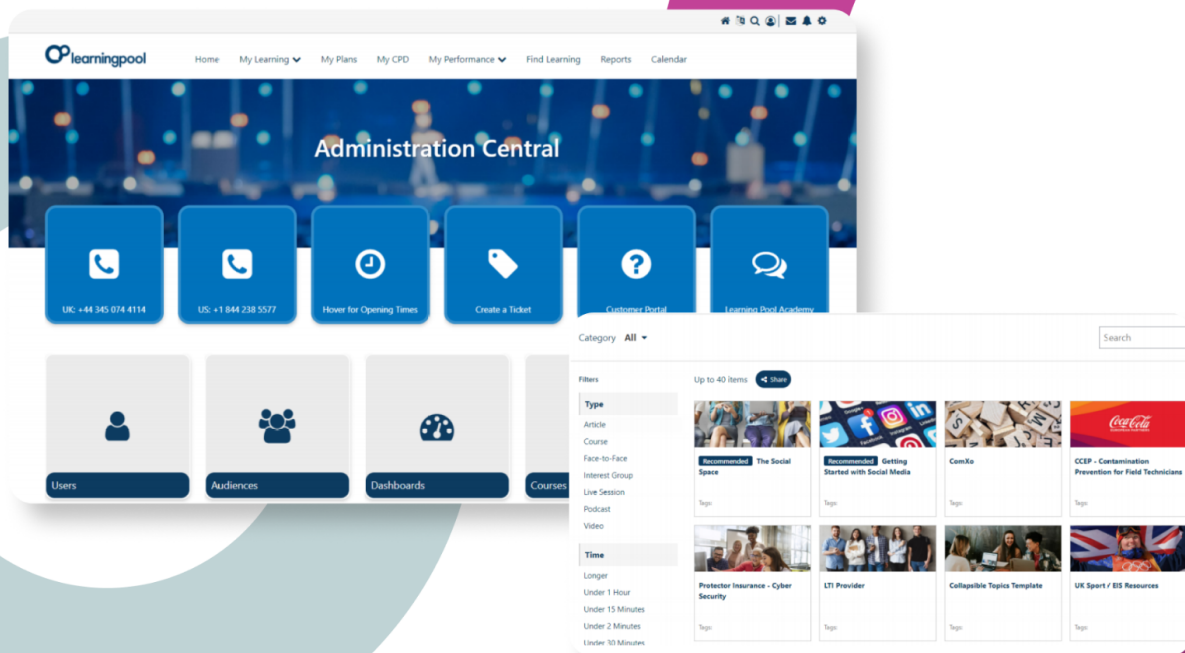

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TL;DR – What's new?

We've been busy over the past few months and this set of releases has something for everyone. The headline addition is **QR Code Attendance for Seminar**, which replaces paper sign-in sheets and retrospective data entry with a fast, self-service check-in experience. Learners simply scan a QR code on arrival and their attendance is recorded instantly. No paper registers. No chasing up records after the event.

Rounding out the release is a wide range of bug fixes and small enhancements across One Click Compliance, KPI Dashlets, Seminar, the course catalogue, and more. We're continuing to listen to your feedback and invest in platform quality — and there's more to come.

New Features

QR Code Attendance for Seminar

► New Feature

What it is

QR Code Attendance lets learners mark their own attendance at in-person seminar sessions by scanning a unique, time-limited QR code when they arrive. Each session automatically generates its own code, which **facilitators can display on screen or download to print** for the room. Learners scan it with their phone, log in when prompted, and their attendance is recorded instantly, no paper registers, no retrospective data entry, no chasing up incomplete records after the event. **Site Managers** have global control to enable or disable the feature and configure how long codes remain valid before and after a session starts.

Why you'll love it

If your teams run face-to-face training, you'll know the admin burden of paper sign-in sheets and manually updating the LMS after an event. **QR Code Attendance eliminates that entirely.** Attendance records are accurate from the moment a session begins, facilitators are free to focus on delivering training rather than collecting signatures, and learners get immediate confirmation that their attendance has been logged. You asked for a way to modernise in-person sign-in without specialist hardware, this is it. Just a QR code on a screen or a printout in the room.

How to use it

Site Managers can enable the feature at Site Administration > Seminars > Global Settings. From there, you can also configure early check-in windows and code expiry times. Once enabled, every seminar session automatically gets a unique QR code, accessible from the Session Attendance page. Facilitators can display

it full-screen, download it to print, or copy and share the attendance link directly with attendees. Learners who are not yet logged in will be taken to the login page before their attendance is confirmed.
